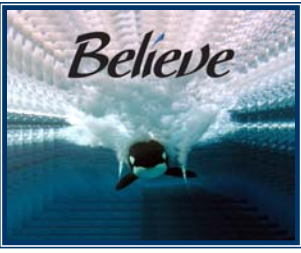


## Greater Michigan PMC Night at the MCAA National Convention
